

## **2017** Back-to-School Checklist for Arts Organizations

Use the checklist to connect with schools as they begin the school year.

Mark your calendar for AEC's Regional Arts Education Day on October 9, 2017.
Continue to learn about the federal Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). Monitor Pennsylvania's state plan and the role of the arts within it, including funding opportunities for districts to partner with arts organizations. The <a href="PA Department of Education's ESSA website">PA Department of Education's ESSA website</a> will continue to be updated as the state's ESSA plan develops.
Connect with schools in your area. Direct emails or phone calls to arts teachers are good places to begin. Most districts publish contact information in staff directories on their websites.
